



RJC High School - 14 Day Quarantine Protocol for International Students:

Following the recommendations of the Saskatchewan Health Authority and the Government of Saskatchewan, international students (students outside of Canada) are required to self-isolate for a 14 day period upon their arrival in Canada.

Students have two options: they may make their own arrangements and isolate at the home of a relative or isolate at the **Best Western Plus Airport Inn & Suites (Best Western)** in the City of Saskatoon as arranged by RJC.

All students are asked to complete a **self-isolation declaration form** prior to their arrival in Canada. See page 3 for this document.

If a student is driving into Canada through the USA, they are still required to self-isolate.

If a student is unable to travel to Canada prior to the first day of school or are in self-isolation when the school year begins (September 7, 2020), distance/online classes will be provided for the student.

Information Regarding Isolation at the Best Western Plus Airport Inn & Suites:

Arrival:

All international students who are arriving at the Saskatoon John G. Diefenbaker International Airport are asked to report their **flight number and arrival time** to RJC once it is available. RJC will pass this information on to the Best Western who will provide transportation from the airport and bring them to their designated room.

Students must arrive **no earlier than Friday, August 14, 2020** in order to receive accommodations at the hotel. If a student is planning to arrive after the school year has already started they must notify the admissions office so alternative arrangements can be made.

During your stay:

RJC students staying at the Best Western will all be staying on the same floor. **Students are not permitted to leave their rooms at any point during the 14 day isolation period.** Each room includes a single or double bed, internet access, television, a small kitchenette, and a private bathroom. If a student needs new linens, towels, or anything else from the hotel during their stay, they are asked to call the front desk to have the items dropped off outside their room door. If anything is broken in a room during the students stay, they are asked to contact the front desk and the RJC staff and the student will be moved to a new room. The student is responsible for any damages to the room during their stay.

Meals:

Meals will be provided and delivered by the RJC kitchen staff and left outside of the students door. Some meals can be refrigerated and reheated in the student's private hotel room kitchenette. Dietary restrictions notes will be taken off the students RJC application.

Supervision:

An RJC staff member will be available 24-7 during the student's 14 day isolation period. While students will not make in-person contact with RJC staff, regular check-ins via phone, zoom, etc. will be provided. If a student is in need of RJC staff or if they are beginning to show symptoms of COVID-19, they are asked to call (306) 232-4222.

Fees:

RJC has received a discounted rate of \$99.00 (CAD) plus tax / night at the Best Western. Students are asked to pay a flat rate of \$2,000 (CAD) to RJC prior to their arrival in Canada to cover the cost of their room, meals, and transportation. These funds are simply to cover the cost of the students stay up to 14 days. If the student wishes to stay at the hotel beyond the 14 day period it will be at the students expense.
