FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Bursaries:

RJC attempts to make school costs affordable to families who are interested. Financial assistance is available for eligible families on a case-by-case basis, and the amount given is dependant on the situation of the student or family. If you are applying or re-applying for financial assistance, please request a Financial Assistance Form from admissions@rjc.sk.ca.

Scholarships available:

- MC Alberta Scholarship - \$4,000
 - Out of Province Alumni Scholarship - \$2,000
- Eligible students may apply for a bursary, and up to one scholarship.*

NOTES TO FEES:

- a) **Out-of-Province Fees:**
 - Saskatchewan Ministry of Education offers grants to Saskatchewan students only, hence out-of-province students have a higher tuition rate.
- b) **Tuition & Dormitory Fees:**
 - Tuition fees are refundable on a prorated basis according to the number of days the student has been enrolled, up until **October 31** (Semester I) and **March 1** (Semester II). Fees after those dates are non-refundable. Dorm fees are refundable on a prorated basis, according to the number of days the student has been enrolled.
