DRIVER EDUCATION:

___ **Driver Education** 265 *To be eligible for a Saskatchewan Driver's License a person must take a Driver Education Course. There is no cost for Saskatchewan students who are taking this course for the first time. For students from other provinces or students who need to complete or repeat the Driver Education course, the cost will be approximately \$750.*

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TIMETABLE

At each grade level the timetable offers **required courses**. These will include courses required by **Saskatchewan Ministry of Education as well as those required by RJC High School**. We look to have students all take a package of courses deemed important for a rounded or holistic education.

The timetable is made of a combination of **semestered and non-semestered classes**. The 25-minute **study hall time** is an important part of the school day. It allows all students the opportunity to obtain extra help from their teachers at this time. All students must attend study hall, and some students will be asked to attend a particular study hall regularly when situations warrant.

The timetable has **six blocks** and student may only have **one block** without a registered curriculum course. Students not in a registered course are expected to register in a teacher-supervised **academic prep** period, where daily attendance is expected. Under certain circumstances we will allow students to complete classes in a **self-directed classroom** with a teacher supervisor. This would allow students to complete earlier courses that were missed or allows them to work in an environment with a great chance for success.
