All students will meet in the dining hall for breakfast, followed by an assembly in the chapel, and then classes.

STUDENT REGISTRATION FOR DAY STUDENTS will take place **Friday, September 3** between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm in the RJC Gymnasium. Please email admissions@rjc.sk.ca to book an appointment to register.

STUDENT REGISTRATION & MOVE-IN FOR DORM STUDENTS will take place **Monday, September 6** between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm in the RJC Gymnasium. Please email admissions@rjc.sk.ca to book an appointment to register. **Dorm students are asked to register BEFORE they move into the dorms.** Following registration, dorm students may continue to the dorms to receive further move-in instructions from the Deans.

During registration **students will receive a timetable** based on their course requests, and will be able to make any necessary changes. **Tuition fees and payment arrangements** are finalized at the time of registration as well.

ALL-STUDENT ORIENTATION SOCIAL - All students, both day and dorm, are expected to meet in the gym and participate in orientation activities on **Monday evening, September 6 at 7:00 pm** (details will be posted that day). The Student Representative Council and Student Community Council will lead fun activities to help students meet and begin to know and feel comfortable with each other.

- 1. STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL and STUDENT COMMUNITY COUNCIL 2021-22** - If you hold a position on SRC or SCC, prepare to return to RJC on **Saturday, September 4 at 10:00 am**. The time together will include planning for the student arrivals and group social events on Monday, getting organized for the year, and looking at/learning about being leaders. A letter from the Deans and Karalee has been sent about this.
- 2. RJC DRESS CODE INFORMATION** - The purpose of the dress code at RJC is to ensure that the students are dressed in a manner consistent with the school's values by wearing neat, clean and inoffensive clothing. The dress code should limit the cost for school dress, and hopefully will also help to instill a sense of pride in and identity with RJC.

Students will receive 3 pieces of dress code on registration day (such as a golf shirt or a sweatshirt). Pants/skirts will need to be provided on your own. More information on dress code expectations can be found in the “Student Handbook 2021-2022” booklet.

- 3. SEPTEMBER CLASS RETREATS** - All grades at RJC plan and enjoy a time together as a class at a retreat scheduled near the beginning of the school year (away from the RJC campus if applicable). The purposes of these retreats include an opportunity for fun, building relationships, learning and worship. These retreats are part of the school curriculum and attendance is required for all RJC students. Please ensure that your child has a sleeping bag or bedding that can be taken along for these retreats.

4. OTHER FORMS YOU MAY NEED:

- a. **COURSE REGISTRATION 2020-21** –If your student has not yet received a course registration form or has not filled it out and returned it, please download a copy from the RJC website, **complete it and return it before August 1st**.

As course availability is based on these requests, it is very important that these forms be sent in as soon as possible, and especially **before** Registration Day. A temporary timetable will be prepared based on their selections and finalized on Registration Day. These forms can be emailed, faxed or mailed back to the school.

- b. **VEHICLE REGISTRATION FORM** – You may choose to allow your student to have a vehicle on campus. However, use of personal vehicles is determined by the agreement between the student, parent and school. If your student is planning to have a vehicle on campus they must fill out a Vehicle Registration form. Day students may use private vehicles for daily travel to and from RJC. They must be parked in assigned lots for the academic day.

During the winter months we are able to provide a limited number of parking spaces with plug-ins for students with vehicles, particularly local students who need to drive to school everyday. The cost for an electrical parking spot is yet to be determined for the upcoming year, but will be approximately \$100 to \$125. The spaces are located directly behind the gymnasium and will be assigned when reserved.

- c. **OUT OF PROVINCE STUDENT TRANSCRIPTS** - If you are attending RJC this year as a new student from out of province or out of country and have already earned grade 10, 11 and/or 12 credits at your home school, you need to arrange for an official transcript of marks to be sent to RJC High School as soon as possible. The SK Ministry of Education requires this transcript to evaluate and transfer your credits to the Saskatchewan system. **Please note: This must be an official transcript and not just a report card.** Information on how to obtain these transcripts should be available through your local school or your province’s government websites. If at all possible, please request this transcript immediately upon completion of the current school year from your Provincial Ministry of Education, so your transcript can be evaluated prior to your arrival.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

In an effort to decrease student contact and shared materials, we ask students to bring the following school supplies for this year:

- binders and loose-leaf paper
- pens, pencils, erasers
- pencil case
- required: scientific calculator – recommended: graphing calculator*
- ruler
- pencil crayons
- markers
- glue sticks
- scissors

***Graphing Calculator:** The current guide for senior mathematics requires the use of a graphing calculator for various topics in the Math 20 and 30 courses. If your student is taking Math Foundations 20/30 or Math PreCalculus 20/30, they will need to purchase a **calculator with Graphing, Statistics, Business & Finance components on it.**

We recommend the Casio fx-9750GII graphing calculator. Regardless of what brand you purchase, please ensure that you purchase a model that has the finance and statistics components on it.
