

# RJC Safe School Plan 2021/2022

effective February 28, 2022



The following plan has been developed in accordance with the province's 2021/2022 *Safe Schools Plan*, and in consultation with local Medical Health Officers.

RJC follows all Public Health Orders and this plan may change, or be updated, at any time if deemed necessary. On February 28, 2022 the government lifted all remaining Covid-19 regulations in the province.

Our goal is to keep our students and staff safe while maintaining in-person learning and school programming.

## **RJC High School's COVID-19 safety protocols are based on the province's 2021/2022 *Safe Schools Plan* categories, which are as follows:**

1. Safe Attendance
2. Safe Classrooms & Learning Spaces
3. Safe Access
4. Safe Transportation
5. Safe Facilities
6. Safe Activities
7. Safe Dormitories & Dining Hall

### **1. Safe Attendance**

- a) Students, staff and guests are expected to stay home when sick and return once symptom free
- b) Staff will support students who need to be away from in-person learning due to illness

### **2. Safe Classrooms & Learning Spaces**

- a) Though masks are no longer required, RJC continues to be a mask-friendly school
- b) Disposable masks will be made available at the school entrances
- c) Hand sanitizers are available in all common areas and classrooms

### **3. Safe Access**

- a) Guests are welcome on campus, but are asked to stay home if feeling ill

### **4. Safe Transportation**

- a) All staff and students are asked to refrain from using school transportation if feeling ill

### **5. Safe Facilities**

- a) Sanitizer stations are available in all classrooms, washrooms and public entrances

### **6. Safe Activities**

- a) RJC is currently participating in all extra-curricular activities
- b) When travelling, RJC High School students and staff will observe all COVID-19 protocols at the host organization

### **7. Safe Dormitories & Dining Hall**

- a) Guests in the dormitories and dining hall are asked to stay home if feeling ill
- b) Sanitizer is available and proper hand hygiene is encouraged
- c) Dining Hall staff will plate food for students behind a plexiglass barrier
