Students not scheduled for a class will be assigned an **Academic Prep**. Attendance at Academic Prep is mandatory and students are expected to be completing schoolwork during this time. Students at RJC are required to pick a minimum of ten courses and may only have one Academic Prep per semester. Not all electives may be offered, depending on student interest and teacher availability. If there is a course not listed that you are interested in taking, please let us know. Students final timetable will be reviewed at registration day, during a meeting with students, parents, and admin.
