**Fees:**

**Tuition fees help cover school expenses such as:**

- Academic fees & student activity fees
- Athletic fees & team travel expenses
- Music & arts fees
- Core travel expenses for school trips
- Dress code shirt (3 for new students, 1 for returning students)
- Weekday lunches, after-school snack & night lunch in the dining hall
- Capital replacement

**Dormitory fees help cover school expenses such as:**

- Room & board (includes all meals)
- Community events & weekend activities
- Staff supervision & student care
- Internet & streaming services
- Laundry access
- Utilities

**Other fees:**

Grade 12 Graduation Fee	\$250
Damage Deposit Fee ( <i>dorm &amp; day students, refundable</i> )	\$250
Shuttle Service Fee ( <i>available to day students</i> )	\$200/month
Single occupancy dorm room ( <i>only available upon special request</i> )	additional \$150/month

\* There may be times when students are asked to pay an additional fee for longer-term, overnight trips.

**Financial assistance:**

**Bursaries:**

RJC attempts to make school costs affordable to families who are interested. Financial assistance is available for eligible families on a case-by-case basis, and the amount given is dependant on the situation of the student or family.

**Automatically applied scholarships available:**

- Mennonite Church Alberta scholarship - \$4,000
- Out of Province Alumni scholarship - \$2,000
- Automatically applied to eligible students*

**New student entrance awards (must apply):**

- Hans & Elsie Funk Award for Scholastic Achievement - \$400 (two awards for a new Grade 10 & 11 student)
- Jacob G. Nickel Scholarship - \$1,600
- John & Elizabeth Armbruster Scholarship - \$2,500
- Edna Regehr Bernstein Scholarship - \$1,000
- Richard Penner Science Scholarship - \$1,000

**Notes to fees:**

**a) Out-of-Province Fees:**

- Saskatchewan Ministry of Education offers grants to Saskatchewan students only; hence out-of-province students have a higher tuition rate.

**b) Tuition & Dormitory Fees:**

- Tuition fees are refundable on a prorated basis according to the number of days the student has been enrolled, up until **October 31** (Semester I) and **March 1** (Semester II). Tuition fees after those dates are non-refundable. Dorm fees are refundable on a prorated basis, according to the number of days the student has been enrolled.
