RJC Final Exam Guidelines and Expectations

Exam Expectations

- Exams are assigned seating in classrooms. A seating chart will be posted on the door.
- Morning exams begin at 8:30 am, and afternoon exams begin at 1:00 pm.
- Students are given 2 hours to write their RJC exams and are required to be present for the entire time.
- Thirty minutes of additional time will be granted to all students as needed.
- Cell phones, laptops, and other devices are not permitted in the exam room at any time.
- When students have completed their exam they may use the remainder of their time to study for their next exam.
 - Students must bring necessary study materials, such as binders and books, to their exam. They will not be permitted to return to the dormitory to gather items.

Attendance

- Students are expected to be ready and on-time for their exams.
- Students not writing an exam are still expected to be in their assigned seats at 8:30 AM. They may use this time to study for their next exam.
 - If a student has two exam blocks before their next exam they only need to be at the exam block prior to their next exam.
 - Day students who do not have an exam scheduled may study at home if their parents or guardians contact the school.

Afternoons

- **Day students** may study at home if their parents or guardians contact the school.
- **Dormitory students** who have no scheduled exam in the afternoon are expected to remain on-campus for the academic day (until 3:00 PM).
- Supervised sessions will be organized during the afternoons, and all students are encouraged to attend.
- Students are strongly encouraged to use their afternoon time to study and prepare for their exams. They are also welcome to use the gymnasium and workout rooms during this time.

Last Final Exam

- If a student is writing their final exam of the week they must write for a minimum of 1 hour, but are free to leave once their exam is completed.
