### **Final Exam Guidelines and Expectations**

- Exams are assigned seating in the chapel (and conference room as needed)
- Morning exams begin at 8:30 am, and afternoon exams begin at 1:00 pm.
- Students are given 2 hours to write their RJC exams and are required to be present for the entire time.
- Thirty minutes of extra time will be granted, if needed.
- Students not writing an exam are expected to be present for their next exam.
- If a student has two exam blocks before their next exam they only need to be at the exam block prior to their next exam.
- Day students may study at home if their parents or guardians contact the school
- Dormitory students who have no scheduled exam in the afternoon are expected to remain on-campus for the academic day.
- If a student is writing their final exam of the week they must write for a minimum of 1 hour, but are free to leave once their exam is completed.
